situation, write up report

Laboratory experiment, set-up situation, not real, subject, control subject, sample, equipment

Observation watch, record

Case study investigation, survey (telephone survey, postal survey)

Experience witness

Statistics data analysis

Placement a job, usually as part of a course of study, which gives you experience of a particular type of work

Data collection

visit organizations, interview people, telephoning, taking photos, write up report, analyse data, at random
